COURSE PROGRAMME OUTLINE

Day 1 Saturday Travelling Day

- Arrival of participants
- 19H00 **Welcome drink** followed by dinner
- Evening: **Guided tour** of Salignac

Day 2 Sunday

- Breakfast
- 9H15-12H30 Classes - N.B. morning sessions all include a coffee break
- 12H30-13H45 Lunch
- 13H45-15H30 Classes
- 18H45 Aperitif and dinner
- 20H45 **Guided tour** of the medieval town of Sarlat-la-Canéda (bus departs 20H15 and returns around 23H00)

Day 3 Monday

- N.B. From day 3, morning sessions will be split into Level 1 and Level 2 (except Friday)
- 12H30-13H45 Lunch

The following topics will be covered during the classes:

- Getting to know each other
- Giving personal information
- Giving information about others
- Vocabulary for physical description, incl. parts of the body
- Clothes and colours
- Asking/answering questions
- Verbs in the present tense
- The French alphabet
- Problem sounds practice
- Number practice
- The French calendar and festivals
- Use of songs in FL teaching
- Use of storytelling in FL teaching – if time
- Level 1: introduction to past tenses and practice
- Level 2 : practice of future tenses, past tenses and other verb forms as required
- Increasing fluency in French
- Exchanging ideas for activities/lesson plans/progressions with colleagues (*)
- Examples of good practice (*)
- Group work - each group will be presenting one activity to the rest of the class (*)
- Use of ICT in FL teaching: looking at websites and on-line resources, interactive CD-Roms, e-stories, etc. (*)
- Looking at French magazines for children
- Presentation and discussion on the French school system
- Role playing
