- a visit to the *Château de Castelnaud*, a stunning medieval French fortress, overlooking the river Dordogne. This includes hands on activities, audio visual displays and a demonstration of medieval sword fights!
- a visit to the stunning *Gouffre de Proumeyssac*, also known as the "Crystal Cathedral", with its spectacular stalagmites and stalactites.
- *Pétanque*, ping pong, volleyball and other sports activities will also be organised.

Cost

£250 per child (min. 30 children). This includes: full board accommodation for 5 days and 4 nights; course fee; visits and outdoor activities; transfer to/from Bergerac Airport for a group of up to 60 pupils. We can help you organise your travel to Bergerac. All the accommodation and facilities comply with French health and safety requirements.
